Design

and use:

Your glove is designed for maximum camera security with two re-enforcing bands. The Velcro sandwich will never unfasten with normal use and the camera jacket will protect your camera from dust, dirt and mild rain showers. It is best to switch the camera off and secure it into the glove before putting the glove on, pay attention to aligning the function switch hole before fastening the Velcro. We also recommend taping the zoom switch after the desired zoom is set to prevent inadvertent zooming. Pull the closing flap tightly around the camera and position it fully into the retaining flap, this will result in a tighter fit and better camera stability. Turn the camera on after the glove is on and comfortable, this should retain your camera settings and ensure success.

More comfort and circulation can be achieved by unfastening the zip after deployment, the camera remains secure (canopy flight). There is a technique to zipping up the glove, which takes some practice. Turn your hand until your palm faces upwards, bend wrist back then zip it up while pulling the slider away from your skin. We recommend that for use in extreme conditions (freefall) you close the zip and grip the knuckle band with a closed fist. This tight grip also enables good directional control. If you have a custom glove for a bigger camera you'll need to learn to pivot your wrist a little more as we cannot get as much angle on these in manufacture.

Note: The zip will become easier to operate once it wears in a little.

Care:

If necessary, hand wash your glove in warm soapy water. The pile Velcro that secures the camera is designed to be easily replaced. Any rigger can do this or you can return it to us for replacement, we are so confident in the HC Gloves ability to go the distance that we will replace the Velcro for free (excluding shipping). Please replace this Velcro if necessary, as this is far less expensive than a replacement camera. Inspect the stitching regularly and especially after a hard landing, remember that the glove has to secure your valuable investment.

Updates:

Our HC Gloves now ship with mounting points for the optional **HC Alti mounting straps**, these straps can be ordered separately and are available for Alti2/3 backing plate style and Barrigo thread through style. HC Pro Gloves also have as standard, a mount for a **Neptune digital altimeter** and **CamEye HCR** which allow one handed camera control, jump logging and alti awareness. Check the web site news for updates and the FAQs for questions.

Note: If you are taking Hand-Cam video and you are not using a Black Eye Lens your footage can be **dramatically improved** by upgrading to one of these lenses. **It is a fact that Hand-Cam video is best with the widest view possible.** The Black Eye Lens is purpose made for Hand-Cam and is currently the widest low profile lens available.
